

City of Niagara Falls 2022 Annual Action Plan Awards

The City of Niagara Falls has estimated an allocation of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in the amount of **\$2,300,000** and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds of **\$208,000** by the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) for the 2022 program year.
