FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. How do I bring a gun to the drop off site?

A. Guns must be UNLOADED and placed in a plastic bag, a paper bag, or a box.

Q. Can I transport the firearm in a car?

A. Yes, but it must be UNLOADED and in the trunk in a plastic bag, a paper bag, or a box.

Q. When do I get the debit card for the firearm? After the UNLOADED gun is received and screened by the officers you will be issued a debit card in the appropriate amount.

Q. How many firearms can I turn in?

A. As many as you wish to provide.

Q. Can I turn in a non-working rifle or shotgun or pistol? Yes, all are accepted.

Q. Can any member of the public turn in a gun?

A. Licensed gun dealers, and active or retired law enforcement officers are not eligible for this program.

Q. Do I need any identification to turn in a firearm?

A. No. This is an Amnesty program and no questions are asked of the person dropping off the firearm.
