Niagara Falls Mayor Vince Anello will be hosting an informational public meeting on Monday September 10, 6pm at the American Legion LaSalle Post 1142, 8643 Buffalo Avenue to discuss proposed improvements to the greater LaSalle area waterfront.

Currently the City of Niagara Falls is considering improvements that would entail boat docks, restaurants, benches, picnic tables and other possible local improvements in the greater area of the Buffalo Avenue waterfront and what is commonly referred to as the, “Century Club property.”

“These improvements have been discussed in general terms for some time now and I feel it’s time to take it to the next level,” said Mayor Anello. “We want to hear from residents with regards to the long range plans for the LaSalle area waterfront,” added the Mayor.

A grant is presently being pursued by the City which would make funding of some of the proposed improvements possible.
