U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Reviews Cleanup at Dupont-Necco Park Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting its second five-year review of the Dupont-Necco Park Superfund Site, Niagara Falls, Niagara County, New York.

This review seeks to confirm that the cleanup conducted at the site, which included installation of a hydraulic containment system, extraction and on-site treatment of groundwater, a landfill cap and long term monitoring, continues to protect human health and the environment. A summary of cleanup activities and an evaluation of the protectiveness of the implemented remedy will be included in the five-year review report.

What is an EPA Five-Year Review?

The purpose of five-year reviews is to ensure that implemented remedies at Superfund sites function as intended and continue to be protective of human health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, include:

- * Inspection of the site and cleanup technologies;
- * Review of monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records, and
- * Determination if any new relevant regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized.

When will EPA's Five-Year Review Report be available?

It is anticipated that the five-year review report will be available at the website noted below by September 2014.
