



The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting its third five-year review of the Dupont-Necco Park Superfund Site, Niagara Falls, Niagara County, New York.

This review seeks to confirm that the cleanup conducted at the site continues to protect human health and the environment. A summary of cleanup activities and an evaluation of the protectiveness of the implemented remedy will be included in the five-year review report. EPA expects the five-year review report will be completed by December 31, 2018.
