I. Purpose:

- A. The Niagara Falls Police Department recognizes the need for newly appointed lieutenants to receive training in management, leadership and accepted supervisory practices. All supervisory personnel need to remain current in their knowledge of accepted and new management techniques.

II. Policy:

- A. It is the policy of the Niagara Falls Police Department that all first line supervisors will successfully complete a police supervision course within one (1) year from the date of promotion. The Municipal Police Training Council must approve this course.
- B. All supervisors will receive annual training to enhance their supervisory skills. This will be coordinated by the Training Director. Additionally, supervisors are encouraged to submit requests to the Superintendent of Police to attend any schools, seminars or training sessions on courses of study that will enhance their skill level. Supervisors will be made aware of any such training that becomes available.
- C. Training records, lesson plans or other means of verifying this training will be maintained by the Training Director.
