2018 Leaf Pick Up Schedule

NIAGARA FALLS, N.Y. - Today, Mayor Paul A. Dyster and John Caso, Director of Parks and Public Works announced the city's leaf pick up schedule for the 2018 fall season.

This year, leaf pickup will begin in the DeVeaux area on Tuesday, November 13.

Crews will then work south through the downtown corridor, toward Buffalo Avenue to Cayuga Island and the LaSalle neighborhood.

Raking and bagging leaves in clear, plastic bags for curbside pickup is encouraged. Up to 10 bags can be placed at the curb for pickup on the regularly scheduled trash day. Acceptable yard waste for pickup includes: weeds, grass clippings, flowers, garden plants and leaves.

Please remember to remove all items, such as portable basketball hoops from the city margin as they impede the city right of way and could be damaged during pick up. Place refuse and recycling carts out only for the allotted time: 5 PM the night before pick up day through 11 PM of pick up day.
