Call for Artists: City Hall Art Gallery Selection 2011

The City of North Olmsted's Cultural Activities Commission is soliciting artwork from local artists to display on a temporary basis at the North Olmsted City Hall. This is an opportunity for artists and art groups to introduce or expand upon the visibility of their artwork through interaction with the local viewing public.

Purpose of the visual arts exhibition spaces

- To provide exhibition space free of charge to local artists, increasing opportunities for both emerging and established artists to exhibit works of art in a public space
- To provide access and exposure to the arts for the residents of North Olmsted
- To enhance public awareness and to promote the visual arts in the City

Artwork suitable to gallery venue

Art will be displayed in City Hall, a building designed to accommodate the general public and where the public is invited to freely visit the exhibition areas unsupervised. Artists are asked to keep in mind that the building may not be a suitable venue for exhibiting all forms of artwork.

How to apply

Submissions may include up to five images of recent artwork. These images may be submitted as photographs or digital .jpg images on a CD. It is recommended that the images reflect recent work and be representative of the intended direction of the art proposed.

Application and Selection Process

Artists awarded exhibitions during this selection will have their work exhibited at City Hall for a period of three months in 2011 (April-June, July-September, October-December). Artists wishing to apply for an exhibit at City Hall must follow the application procedures below; applications will be accepted on a rolling basis. The Cultural Activities Commission shall select the artists to be awarded exhibitions and the period of display.

Application Procedures

1. Interested artists are invited to submit their application to the North Olmsted Cultural Activities Commission at the address below.
2. Enclose with the completed application up to five (5) photographs or .jpg digital images on CD.
3. Images must be numbered and correspond to the image list which indicates the sizes, media, and titles of the works.
