ROLL CALL

Chair Yustick called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m. at the North Olmsted Branch Library.

REVIEW AND CORRECTION OF MINUTES

Mr. Wahl moved, seconded by Mr. Kepperley, to approve the November 3, 2010 minutes, which was approved 5-0.

OLD BUSINESS

Holiday Lighting Contest

Commissioners discussed dropping off Holiday Lights flyers to homes that they see lit up to increase the number of entries. Mr. Kepperley said he submitted information to the Westlife a week ago but has not heard from anyone. The deadline for the contest is December 13, 2010 so the commission will need to have a meeting to announce the winners. They will meet on Wednesday, December 15, 2010 at the North Olmsted Library at 7:00 pm. Participation this year may determine whether the contest continues next year.

Art Show/Northern Ohio Music Festival

The Olmsted Festival of the Arts brochure was submitted and Mr. Kepperley said the brochure would include the logo once it is designed which should be prior to January. The commissioners liked the layout and felt it was very informational and eye catching. Mr. Kepperley reviewed the timeframe in which he would submit information to the papers so it could be advertized. The commission will vote on the layout of the brochure in January once the logo is inserted, final colors added and the application portion placed in line with the returned address section.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Dover Players

Mrs. Martindale submitted a copy of a letter that was sent to Frostville Museum member Paul Schumann from the Dover Players requesting to perform a play on their new stage. She noted that one of the dates could be in conflict with the Olmsted Festival of the Arts. They would like to perform Midsummer's Night Tale. Mr. Kepperley said he was not sure if the stage was completed or what is scheduled at this time. Mrs. Martindale said there would be no props just a

backdrop. The commission had no objections to the request and wished the Dover Players well is scheduling the event. Mrs. Martindale said the last play performed brought in \$2,134 and out of that the director was paid \$600 and the cast party was \$250 for fifteen people. They have removed all items owned by the Dover Players from Old Town Hall. She questioned if there had been any word on when the food bank would be completed and the facility could once again be used. She noted that play dates were submitted for the 2011 calendar year but, has yet to hear whether they are approved.

The commissioners reviewed the proposed calendar for 2011 meeting dates and had no changes.

Mr. Kepperley moved, seconded by Mrs. Martindale, to approve the 2011 meeting dates and times, which was approved 5-0.
