## 2012 COLLECTION PROGRAMS



### Household Hazardous Waste Round Up

Spring: April 16 through April 30

Summer: July 9 through July 23

Fall: September 11 through September 24

Drop off location: Service Yard / Fleet Garage at 5200 Dover Center Road

Oil or solvent-based paint, sealers, primers, or coatings (aerosols or liquids)

Varnishes, polyurethanes, shellacs

Paint thinner, mineral spirits, turpentine

Pesticides, herbicides, fungicides

Caustic household cleaners

Pool chemicals

Automotive fluids, motor oil, car batteries

Adhesives, roof tar, driveway sealer

Kerosene, gasoline, lighter fluid

Mercury, fluorescent bulbs

**No Latex paint** Latex paint is comprised mostly of water and is not a hazardous

material to dispose of latex paint dry it out by removing the lid. Once it has solidified you

place in your curbside trash

**\*\*\*Any type of liquid waste oil in a sealed container will be taken year round**

### Computer Round Up

Year Round

Drop off location: Service Yard / Fleet Garage at 5200 Dover Center Road Items

collected: CPU's, monitors, keyboards, software, mice, printers, terminals,

modems, ink jet cartridges, cell phones, etc.

### Scrap Tire Round Up

August 27 through September 9

Drop off location: Service Yard / Fleet Garage at 5200 Dover Center Road Items

collected: Used tires without rims only.

\*\*You can dispose of your old tires through your tire retailer at the time of purchase of new tires.

### Paper and Cardboard Container Recycling

Year Round

Drop off location: Cardboard/Paper Dumpster at 5200 Dover Center Road

Items collected: Paper, cardboard, junk mail, phone books, newspaper, magazines and shoeboxes. No food packing/containers or pizza boxes

### Phone Book Recycling Campaign

Drop off location: 5200 Dover Center Road

Cardboard/Paper Dumpster at Year Round

June 5 through September 28

Rocky River Reservation Service Center, Mill Parking Lot

### Appliance (Freon) Curbside Collection

Year Round

Items collected: Any appliance containing Freon; refrigerators, freezers, air conditioning units, dehumidifiers, etc.
