NOVEMBER UPDATE

INCOME TAX COLLECTIONS FOR THE CITY OF NORWALK

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2017

Effective January 1, 2017, the Regional Income Tax Agency (RITA) will become responsible for the administration and collection of all City of Norwalk income taxes.

Registered taxpayers will be receiving a welcome letter from RITA in early December. Please be sure to watch for this letter.

For the remainder of 2016, all payments, including 2016 estimated tax payments will continue to be payable to the City of Norwalk.

If your payment will not reach the City of Norwalk until after December 31, 2016, please send your payment to RITA. Your check should be made payable to RITA. More information will follow on this process in the upcoming welcome letter.

Additional important information for business taxpayers

For those taxpayers utilizing Ohio Business Gateway, RITA will be contacting them and payments and filings will be redirected to RITA sometime after December 31, 2016.

Any withholding payments mailed after January 1, 2017 must be sent to RITA.

The 2016 W-2's and annual W-3 Reconciliation report must be sent to RITA
