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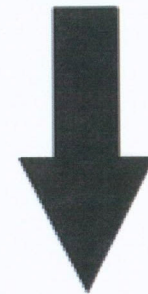

and you anticipate owing us again this year.  
This most often occurs when

- You work outside of Norwalk and your employer is not required to withhold tax
- You work outside of Norwalk and your employer withholds at the local rate that is less than the Norwalk tax rate
- You are self-employed

**AND**

1. Complete the Declaration of Estimated Taxes at the bottom of the annual return.
2. Make your estimated payments each quarter. Make the first payment when you file your annual return. You will be billed for the remaining payments due on the last day of July, October, and January.

**IMPORTANT TIP:**

3. Pay your estimate in full by January 31. You must pay an amount equal to 90% of what you actually owe. You might ask, "How can I know what I will owe before I file my return that is not due until April 15<sup>th</sup>?" Good question. You can find your earnings on your final pay stub for the year and calculate the tax you will owe OR you can pay the same amount that was due last year and avoid any penalty.



What is the penalty if I fail to pay my estimated taxes?

**PENALTY:** NON-FILING  
PENALTY OF \$25

**INTEREST:** 1.5% A MONTH  
OR FRACTION OF A MONTH FROM  
DUE DATE OF EACH QUARTERLY  
INSTALLMENT
