



**2012 Papillion Half Marathon, 10K & Community Fun Walk.
Presented by Alegent Health Midlands Hospital
Sunday, May 20th 2012**

Due to the size and location of the event, it will be necessary to close or limit traffic throughout various parts of the Papillion community for safety reasons. Based on where you live or where you may be traveling the morning of May 20th, please note the following roadway restrictions:

- If you are planning a visit or camping at the **Walnut Creek** campgrounds please know that there will be no vehicular traffic allowed into or out of the south entrance from Schram Road from 6:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. and the east entrance from 96th Street from 6:00 am until approximately 9:30 a.m.
- **108th Street from Hwy 370 to Schram Road** will be closed from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. Entrance only by vendors, spectators and participants of the event.
- **Schram Road between 96th Street and 114th Street** will be closed from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.
- **96th Street between Schram Road and Hwy 370 (South Bound Lane)** will be closed from 6:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. **Residents in the cul-de-sacs off 96th street will be able to go north on 96th Street.**
- Residents of **Santa Fe Circle** will have restricted access in and out of the cul-de-sac from 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Volunteers will be on hand to assist with traffic; runners will be entering the trail on 96th street from under the bridge at Hwy 370 in this neighborhood. Extreme caution will be required.
- Motor vehicle traffic will **ONLY** be allowed southbound on 96th Street in the eastern most lane from Lincoln Street to Santa Fe Circle 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- Motor vehicle traffic will **ONLY** be allowed west bound on **Cornhusker between 96th Street and N. Jackson Street** from 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- **N. Jackson Street between Cornhusker and N. Adams Street** will be closed from 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- **North Adams Street from North Jackson to First Street** will be closed from 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- **1st Street will be closed from N. Adams to 72nd Street** from 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- **American Parkway from 1st Street to 72nd Street** will be open to local traffic only from 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- Motor vehicle traffic will **ONLY** be allowed southbound on **72nd Street** in the eastern most lane from **Cornhusker Road to the Halleck Street** 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

Please use caution and watch for runners and spectators throughout Papillion between the hours of 7:00 am. and 11:30 am.
