

ARTICLE IX
Enforcement; Complaints, Penalties

§ 170-30. Approval required prior to legal filing.

No map, plan, plat or replat of any subdivision within the jurisdiction of this chapter shall be considered legally filed with the Register of Deeds for the county unless and until the same shall have been approved by the governing body.

§ 170-31. Complaints regarding violations.

Whenever a violation of this chapter occurs or is alleged to have occurred, any person may file a written complaint. Such complaint, stating fully the causes and basis thereof, shall be filed with the Planning Director. He/she shall record properly such complaint, immediately investigate and take action thereon as provided by this chapter.

§ 170-32. Violations and penalties.

Any person or persons who violates any of the prohibitions or provisions of any article or section of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100 for any one offense, recoverable with costs. Each and every day that such violation continues after notification shall constitute a separate offense.
