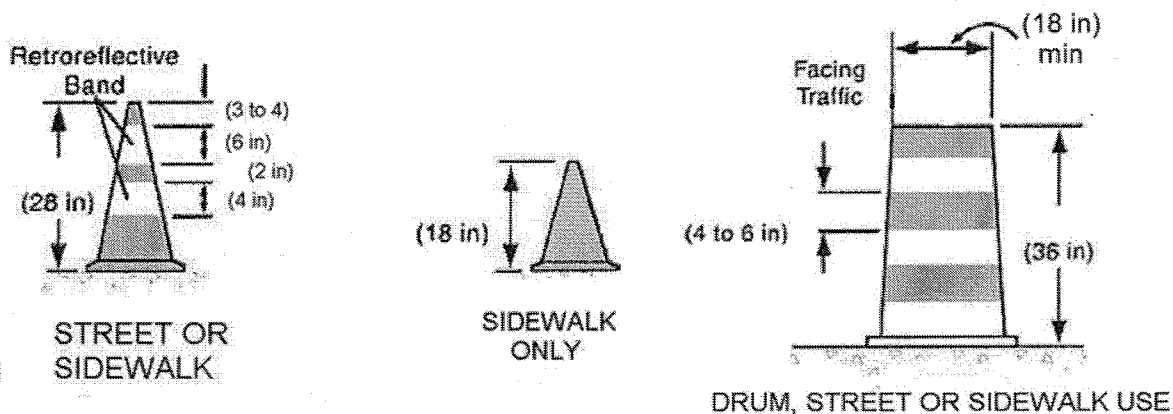

All work zone set-ups within the City of Piqua street right-of-way shall comply with the requirements as set forth in the current Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, OMUTCD.
