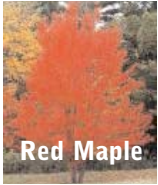

Shade Trees

- Red Maple – *Acer Rubrum*.
Foliage turns brilliant red in the fall.
- River Birch - *Betula Nigra*.
Striking bark, purple red leaf color during the season.
- Black Gum – *Nyssa sylvatica*.
Outstanding fall color.
- Tulip Poplar – *Liriodendron Tulipifera*.
Green flowers in early summer.

Ornamental Trees

- Service Berry – *Amelanchier arborea*.
Green flowers in early summer.
- Redbud – *Cercis Canadensis*.
Purple flowers in spring.
- Dogwood – *Cornus Florida*.
Produces white or pink flowers in the spring.

Trees will be planted 2 times per year.
