Things to Know About AoR 5

There are approximately 50 businesses in AoR 5 comprised of the businesses along Research Forest Dr. and along both sides of a small portion of IH-45. This area is located in the south part of Shenandoah and experiences relatively little crime throughout the year.

AoR 5 has a high number of banks so be aware of those around you and report any suspicious activity to the Shenandoah Police Department immediately.

Vehicle burglaries are also a concern in AoR 5 so follow the crime prevention tips to help deter thieves.

Traffic can be a concern in AoR 5 because of congestion on Research Forest Dr. in the afternoons.
