Alternate Side Parking Program

Alternate-side parking during the winter season allows Skokie's Public Works Department to efficiently plow Village streets. The mandatory program is implemented in order to safely clear village streets within a minimum two-day period.

On odd-numbered dates, residents park vehicles on the odd-numbered side of the street 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. On odd days of the month, all vehicles must be moved to the side of the street with odd numbered addresses. On even-numbered dates, residents park vehicles on the even-numbered side of the street. On even-numbered days of the month, all vehicles must be moved to the side of the street with even numbered addresses. Odd- and even-numbered dates are determined by the dates on the calendar. Odd and even sides of the street are determined by house addresses.

Violators will be ticketed and towed.

Residents may call 847/675-SNOW (7669) or tune to 1660 AM, Skokie's new advisory radio station, to confirm that the alternate-side parking program is in effect and for program updates.

Alternate Side Parking Facts

- The alternate-side parking program is in effect between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. seven days a week after snowfall of at least 2 inches. An alert siren will sound at 7 a.m., which indicates that alternate-side parking is in effect. The alert siren will sound at 6 p.m., which indicates that residents may move their vehicles back to the opposite side of the street.
- Cable television subscribers are alerted through the emergency over-ride system at 6 a.m., 7 a.m., 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Additional information can be found at SkokieVision cable station (channel 25 on RCN and channel 17 on Comcast systems), 1660 AM or by contacting 847/675-SNOW (7669).
- There is a \$50 fine for vehicles that are parked on the wrong side of the street when the Village's alternate-side parking program is in effect.
- The alternate-side parking program generally is in effect for at least two days. To find out if it is extended please call 847/675-SNOW (7669).
- Residents who do not have off-street parking facilities must make arrangements to have vehicles moved when the program is in effect.
