Oakton Station Progress

The new Oakton Station finishes are being installed. The tactile edge tiling, familiar to most CTA riders, is in place and the structure painting is nearly complete. The vibrant edge tile and the terra cotta curtain wall framing add a splash of color within the new station. The granite flooring installation is also underway at both station houses.

Roofing installation continues at the North and South Station Houses, while the permanent site fencing is being installed. Concrete sidewalks, decorative paver bricks and the bicycle canopy will soon be completed. Electrical equipment layout and installation within the station houses is ongoing, equipment is being installed in the communication and electrical huts, and train signal work is underway.

The finish materials installation at each station will continue, including the glass and granite flooring at the South Station House, as well as the ceilings, cabinets and countertops for the customer assistance kiosks.

What's Next

The following activities/installations are expected to begin or continue in the coming weeks:

- Standing seam roofing
- Signal and train equipment
- Site concrete, fencing and unit pavers
- Aluminum curtain wall and window glazing
- Fare control equipment
- Access stairs and platform railing
- Storage bins and benches
- Kiosk and electrical equipment
- Entrance doors
- Station House signage
- Interior lighting fixtures
