1. Call to Order:

First Selectman David Pinney called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

2. Members Present:

Selectmen David Pinney and Kathy Devlin

3. Fiscal Year 2007 – 2008 Salaries:

A motion was made by Kathy Devlin, seconded by David Pinney and unanimously approved to increase all existing salaries by 3% for the fiscal year starting July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008, with the following exceptions:

The salary for Ann Logan, Town Clerk, will be set at \$56,000 annually. The salary for Pat Juda as the Town Assessor will be set at \$55,000. The pay rate for the drivers of the senior buses will be set at \$12.00 per hour.

The salaries and pay scales for all employees subject to collective bargaining are yet to be established through the adoption of contracts by the town and the bargaining units. This means that the salaries for the members of the Land Use Union and the Firefighters Union will stay the same pending the adoption of new contracts. The Town Hall clerical staff that will now be represented by MEUI following the certification of the vote on 6/29/07 will have their salaries set by the contract developed and agreed to through the bargaining process between the town and the members of this new unit as represented by MEUI. Until such contract is adopted, their salaries have to remain as they are currently. There is a contract in force for the police union which will establish new pay scales for members of that unit.

4. Review of Job Openings: This was not discussed.

5. Adjournment:

The meeting adjourned by mutual consent at 4:45 p.m.
