CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS (CIP) COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES APRIL 24, 2014

Attendees; Rob Wilson, Mike Parker, Bill Boutwell, Steve Krasinski, Lisa Pellegrini

Called to Order at 7:00 PM

- I. Several requests were presented by the BOE and BOS for capital projects. These requests are attached as part of these minutes and are summarized as follows;
 - A. BOE request for Computer Network upgrade. Cost \$109,162
 - 1. Request is for 2013 / 2014. \$64,160 and \$45,000 for 2014/15. The BOE wants to start the project ASAP in 2014
 - 2. There is an unexpended BOE, CIP project in 2013 for \$19,000. The BOE does not want this assigned to the upgrade project
 - 3. The current network will not handle the volume of Computers, I óPads, Phones etc.
 - 4. The improvements will be sufficient for use in the next 7- 10 years
 - B.BOS request for Fuel Island Control System. Cost \$9000.00
 - 1. Currently there is no lock on the diesel fuel, therefore pilferage could occur without Town knowledge
 - C. BOS request for Police Cruiser. Cost \$40,000
 - 1. This request was previously presented to the BOF when two police personell were added to the Somers Police.
 - D. BOS request for a tractor. Cost \$47,170
 - E. BOS request for 1 ton pickup for general transportation for DPW. Cost is \$43,880
 - F. BOS request for Snow Plow/ Sander Dump Truck. Cost \$113,500
 - 1. Mike P. stated and presented what he would expect for a vehicle replacement plan. This would eliminate the need for emergency requests. This plan is attached.
 - 2. Currently the DPW has 10 Plow /Sanders, One, 1 Ton Dump /Plow, Two, Pick-ups /Plow.
 - 3. This would replace a 1996 Truck
 - 4. Discussion was held on the need for a vehicle replacement plan based on wear-out / age requirement. None currently exists
 - G. BOS request for Front end Loader for Highway use. Cost \$13,634
- II Motioned by Mike P. seconded by Bill B. to recommend to the BOF to expend \$9000 to purchase a Fuel Island Control Station. All Approved
- III. Lisa (BOS) submitted additional lists of CIP that extended to 2020/21. This list is attached. Lisa stated that a fund should be established for future large projects. No action was taken

- IV. Mike M. discussed that there is unexpended CIP funds of \$600,707.00, not counting the \$300,000 appropriated in 2014/15 budget. Much discussion was held on validity of these numbers. Mike M. insisted that accounting was correct per Town ledgers.
 - 1. Steve stated at this time he is only willing to work with the remaining 2013/14 appropriation, which is (($$341,746 {\'o}$ (\$34,298,+\$36,345,+\$19,296,+\$78,000.+\$60,000), = \$113,807)) and the 2014/15 appropriation of \$300,000
 - 2. Discussion was held on the 2013 appropriation of \$665,000.00. Mike p stated that the \$65,000 was for paying the BAN costs and cannot be used for CIP, Steve agreed. Mike M stated that the \$65,000 was in the budget as an expense. It appears that it was a double dip.
 - 3. There is sufficient confusion on the BOF appropriations for CIP in the last 3 budget years. Mike M. will research BOF minutes to see if approved BOF appropriations match the Ledger accounts that were used to generate the \$600,707 CIP fund.
- V. No other action was taken. Members will study the requests needs. The next meeting will be Monday May 5, 2014 @ 7:00PM
- VI. Mike P. motioned, Steve seconded to adjourn at 8:50 PM, all favored
