❖ **Sec. 19a-301. (Formerly Sec. 19-152). Establishment and management of perpetual funds. Accounting.** (a) Any cemetery association, organized as provided by law, may, by vote of the directors or members of such association, set aside the surplus funds of such association as a perpetual fund. Such fund shall be invested in accordance with the provisions of the statutes concerning the investment of trust funds. Such fund, together with any donation received by an ecclesiastical society or cemetery association pursuant to section 19a-303, **shall be under the control, management and supervision of a committee of not fewer than three persons elected by such association or society.**
