

CT Emergency Alert System

On September 01, 2009, Connecticut became the first state in the nation to have a statewide emergency notification system. CT Alert ENS allows state and local officials to help protect lives and property by providing critical information to residents during emergencies, including dangerous situations. By signing up, you will be alerted to state wide emergencies, via telephone, email or text message. This system differs from the local Somers Emergency Notification System, Reverse 911, which is used exclusively to notify town residents of emergencies.
