Soda machine will be installed very shortly and will contain soda, water and juice. Cost will be \$.90 per drink, 30 cents of which goes to the Society for the Blind. *Picture of the Senior Center has been taken for the new resource guide which will be ready to be handed out shortly. *Newsletter production has been changed to every three months due to the high cost of printing and mailing. Next issue will be for June/July/August.

<u>Meals on Wheels</u> – No news from Susan King this month. It is hoped to have a menu from whoever prepares future meals so that this can be reviewed by a nutritionist to be sure we are satisfying the needs of the clients.

<u>Senior Lunches/Senior Club</u> – No report from the Senior Club this month.

<u>Senior Support</u> – Pat Bachetti is currently working with three patients at Blair Manor. If anyone knows of someone who is a patient at Blair Manor, please let Pat know and she will include them in her program.

<u>Senior Information Guide</u> – Guide is currently finished and waiting for cover/printer to complete. Booklet is ready to go to printing and will be distributed at various areas in town. i.e., Senior Center, Library, Woodcrest, Congregational Church, Drug Store, etc.

OLD BUSINESS:

<u>Resident Coordinator at Woodcrest</u> – Board needs to know where this position stands. Letter will be sent to the Housing Authority seeking more information on this subject.

NEW BUSINESS:

<u>Senior Summit</u> – A special Senior Advisory Board meeting will be held so members can meet with representatives from the Board of Selectmen regarding various issues important to the seniors in town.
