Task 2.2. The Lower Trail has been marked with blue blazes. The Old Shenipsit Trail and Perkins Mountain Trail as far as summit are ready to blaze. A work party is scheduled for Oct. 4<sup>th</sup> to clear the Old Shenipsit Trail connector. Ann Moses will lead the work party. The next priority is flagging and clearing the Perkins Mountain Trail from the summit down to the Lower Trail.

Task 2.9. The Somers Rotary Club previously agreed to adopt a trail created at Camp Aya Po. The SOSTC recommended that the Rotary Club maintain the Lakeside Trail when it is completed in 2016.

Task 3.6. A funding decision on the DEEP grant application for improvements to the South Forest View Trail is expected in October.
