TOWN OF SOMERS PLAN OF CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT STEERING COMMITTEE

REGULAR/PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 12, 2015 7:30PM, TOWN HALL

I. CALL TO ORDER:

II. NEW BUSINESS:

Glenn Chalder, Planimetrics, presented a slide show overview of the "2015 Plan of Conservation and Development."

The PLAN is evolving. Input is being accepted. The PLAN is on the Town website. The target completion for the PLAN is July 2015. Upon completion of the overview, audience participation was encouraged.

- 1. In discussion of the aging population projections of Somers residents in the PLAN one gentleman asked if anything is in the plan for public housing or shared maintenance of residences. He would like to see something.
- 2. A question was asked if the previous PLAN addressed the 'design' of the Center of Town. Lisa Pelligrini responded by saying "yes" and several things have been accomplished in Somersville with sidewalks, streetlights, etc.
- 3. A woman mentioned what she referred to as the 'mess' on Field Road. She was of the opinion that nothing gets accomplished there.
- 4. That brought up the subject of the Mill. Lisa Pelligrini mentioned that although progress is slow because the Mill site is privately owned, progress has taken place and both State and Federal governments are assisting the Town of Somers.
