TOWN OF SOMERS PLAN OF CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT STEERING COMMITTEE

REGULAR MEETING THURSDAY, MARCH 12TH, 2015 6:30PM, TOWN HALL

I. CALL TO ORDER:
