Update:

1. Field #5 (50'/70' field):

a. Field #5 is ready for play,

b. The next projects for this field is a backstop, baseline fencing, player benches and dugouts.

These will all be dependent on future funding.

2. The new parking lot behind Field #4:

a. This parking lot is open and ready for use.

3. T-Ball area next to batting cages:

a. Little League has put on the finishing touches and this area is ready for play.

4. The tree line along the south side of the Town Hall fields was trimmed and cleaned by Little League volunteers and the debris was picked up by DPW.

5. Intersection improvements Ninth District Road / Main Street:

a. Project is now scheduled to resume in the middle of May,

- b. There will be one lane traffic on Main, Ninth DST and Sokol Roads during construction, expect delays,
- c. Ninth DST Road closure is scheduled for June 23rd thru August 26th.
