You could be eligible for Property Tax Relief!

- Are you a Somers' resident?
- Do you own your home or have life use of your home?
- Are you or your spouse 65 years old or older, or are you receiving permanent total disability benefits?
- Is your 2009 adjusted gross income plus any other income not included in your adjusted gross income, \$39,500 or less?

If you answered yes to the questions above, you may qualify for property tax relief. Tax Credits up to 75% of your real estate tax bill are funded by the State of Connecticut and the Town of Somers and never need to be repaid.

Simply come to Town Hall with your 2009 Federal Income Tax Return, if you filed one, plus your 1099's from Social Security, between February 1st and May 14th. The Assessor's staff will assist you in completing the paperwork.
