

ELECTION INFORMATION

Municipal Election

Absentee Ballots are available to any elector eligible to vote at an election, is a United States citizen, and who is not available to vote in person during the regular hours of voting, 6:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on November 03, 2009. The **Application for an Absentee Ballot**, which can either be picked-up or mailed from the Town Clerk's office, must be completed and returned to the office **prior** to the actual ballot being mailed. The application shall be signed by the applicant and shall contain the address to where the ballot is to be mailed. Any person who assists another person in completing the application shall sign the application and indicate residence and telephone number.

Voter Registration Card – must be printed, must have an original signature, and received by either the Registrar of Voters or the Town Clerk's Office

Absentee Ballot Application – must be printed, must have an original signature, and received by the Town Clerk's office prior to the issuance of a ballot

Voting Locations – Voting will take place at the Somers Town Hall Auditorium (lower level), Main Street, and at the Sr. Center located on Battle Street. The Town of Somers has two voting areas separated by the Scantic River and Main Street. Please refer to the Voting Locations Listing.

Identification – Each individual shall present to the checkers, before an elector votes, either a current and valid photo identification that shows the elector's name and address or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document that shows the name and address of the elector.
