Brush removal from side of road continues daily, place brush close to road, with sawed limb side facing outward.

Transfer Station: Open M-F 7:30 a.m. - 3 p.m.; Sat/Sun. 8:30 to 4:30.

Field Road: lower parking lot- brush debris only 7 days per week, 7:30 am – 4:30 pm 7 days per week, 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM
