Details

The City of Sturgis will hold a public meeting on a proposed Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Project Plan Amendment for the purpose of receiving comments from interested persons. The meeting will be held during the regularly scheduled City Commission Meeting on Wednesday, April 26 at 6 p.m. The hearing will be held in the Wiesloch Raum at Sturgis City Hall, 130 N. Nottawa Street.

The distribution main on Treatment Plant Road is a dead-end main. The DWSRF Project Plan Amendment proposes the installation of water main from Treatment Plant Road to the existing main in South Centerville Road. Construction will be completed by open cut at standard water main depth. The estimated monthly user cost for a family of four to finance the proposed project(s) is \$2.03. This cost includes inflation adjusted costs for the three Projects in the original approved Project Plan and the additional cost for the new Project in the Project Plan Amendment.
