## CONSTRUCTION BOARD OF APPEALS

- 1. All appeals applications will be assigned a permanent case number that will be assigned and recorded when the completed application is received by the Building Department.
- 2. Before the secretary is instructed to schedule an Appeals Board meeting, the Building Department will decide if the application represents a matter that could or should be decided on by the Board of Appeals. If so, the Construction Board of Appeals is notified immediately. If not, it is noted that the application does not meet the criteria for the Board of Appeals, the reasons why, and filed. The appellant is notified by mail within ten (10) days.
- 3. Once an application has been approved for an appeals hearing the Board must meet within thirty (30) days of the date (stamped received and initialed by a member of the Building Department) of appeal.
- 4. The Chair will call the hearing to order although it is an open meeting, comments will not be heard from the audience. The hearing will begin with the representative for the City (Code Official) explaining the situation as he has ruled on it citing code sections that are applicable to support the City's case. After the Code Official has introduced the case the appellant will present his case with any (relevant) supporting evidence or documentation.
