Permit Application Checklist

Refer to City of Ordinance section 10-65.—Urban Chickens for all regulations.

Application Process

- Application Completed and Submitted with sketch plan. You may request an aerial map of the property from the City to complete your sketch plan.
 - Sketch plan shall include the following:
 - Location of chicken coop, chicken runs, and fencing. Provide details of height and style of fence and details (drawing or picture of coop). All must be fully enclosed (sides and top covered). Minimum run size is 8 square feet per chicken.
 - Indicate all setbacks (distances in feet) from all property lines and structures on same property.

 No coop or enclosure shall be located closer than 10 feet to any property line of an abutting lot. Chickens coop and enclosure shall only be located in the rear yard.
 - The coop or enclosure shall not be located closer than 40 feet to the nearest residence on an abutting lot (including principal structure, decks, porches, sunrooms or similar areas attached to a principal structure). Indicate dimensions from abutting properties residential structures on sketch plan.
 - Indicate how far the coop and enclosure are from the principal structure (house). This distance must be a minimum of 10 feet.
 - If there are any accessory structures, indicate the distance between the coop/enclosure and the accessory structure. This distance must be a minimum of 3 feet.
 - The principal use of the applicant's property is a single-family dwelling. (Urban chickens are not permitted in multi-family dwellings, multiple single-family dwellings on a single lot, duplex, or apartments.)
 - If the property is a rental, provide written authorization from the property owner.

Inspection Process

- If it is determined that the property meets the ordinance requirements you will be notified and may set up your coop and enclosure for inspection. An inspection will be scheduled. Please note: the application will not be approved, and permit will not be issued until property is found to be in compliance.
 - Coops and enclosures must be clean, dry, odor-free and kept in a neat and sanitary condition.
 - All enclosures shall be constructed or repaired to prevent rats, mice, other rodents, or predators from being harbored underneath, within or within the walls of the enclosure.
 - All feed and other items associated with the keeping of chickens shall be kept in a vermin and predator proof sealed container.
 - Waste materials (feed, manure, and litter) must be disposed of in an environmentally responsible manner. Piling waste materials on the property is not permitted. Litter must be kept dry.
 - The use of corrugated metal/fiberglass, sheet metal, plastic tarps, scrap lumber or similar materials not in keeping with the appearance of other accessory structures in the immediate area of the property will not be permitted, unless approved by the zoning administrator.
 - The use of extension cords will not be permitted.

**The initial inspection is included with your application fee. Any additional inspections will be charged \$50.00 and must be paid prior to the inspection being completed. No permits will be issued until all fees are paid.
