#### **GENERAL NOTES**

- 1. FORTY-EIGHT HOURS BEFORE DIGGING IS TO COMMENCE, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE FOLLOWING AGENCIES: THE OHIO UTILITY PROTECTION SERVICES (OUPS) AND ALL OTHER AGENCIES WHICH MAY HAVE UNDERGROUND UTILITIES INVOLVING THIS PROJECT AND ARE NON-MEMBERS OF OHIO UNDERGROUND PROTECTION, INC.
- 2. EXISTING UNDERGROUND UTILITIES AND SERVICES ARE SHOWN IN THEIR APPROXIMATE LOCATIONS ACCORDING TO THE BEST INFORMATION AVAILABLE. THE LOCATIONS SHOWN ARE INTENDED ONLY AS A GUIDE AND CANNOT BE GUARANTEED ACCURATE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR:
  - a. CONTACTING THE INDIVIDUAL UTILITY OWNERS TEN DAYS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION AND ADVISING THEM OF THE WORK TO TAKE PLACE.
- b. SOLICITING THEIR AID WITH LOCATING AND PROTECTING ANY UTILITY WHICH MAY INTERFERE WITH CONSTRUCTION.
- c. EXCAVATING AND VERIFYING THE HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL LOCATION OF EACH UTILITY PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION AND INFORMING THE ENGINEER OF ANY POSSIBLE CONFLICTS.
- d. ALL DAMAGE TO ANY EXISTING UTILITY.
- ALL PLANS AND CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CURRENT "RULES AND REGULATIONS" OF SYCAMORE TOWNSHIP, HAMILTON COUNTY AND APPLICABLE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION STANDARDS.
- 4. CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN A PERMIT FOR ALL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS.
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR IS TO PERFORM ALL INSPECTIONS AS REQUIRED BY THE OHIO EPA FOR THE NATIONAL POLLUTION DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT AND FURNISH OWNER'S REPRESENTATIVE WITH WRITTEN REPORTS. REPORTS MUST BE PERFORMED EVERY 7 DAYS AND WITHIN 24 HOURS OF A RAIN EVENT OF 1/2 INCH OR GREATER. RECORDS MUST BE KEPT FOR 3 YEARS AFTER THE NOT IS FILED.
- 6. ITEM NUMBERS REFER TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONSTRUCTION AND MATERIAL SPECIFICATIONS, AND ALL CONSTRUCTION WORK SHALL BE DONE IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPLICABLE STANDARDS OF SYCAMORE TOWNSHIP. WHEN IN CONFLICT THE TOWNSHIP REQUIREMENTS SHALL PREVAIL.
- 7. ALL STREET SURFACES, DRIVEWAYS, SIDEWALKS, AND OTHER STRUCTURES THAT ARE DISTURBED OR DAMAGED IN ANY MANNER AS A RESULT OF CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE REPLACED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SPECIFICATIONS AT THE COST OF THE CONTRACTOR IF NOT SPECIFICALLY NOTED IN THE PLANS.
- WHERE PROPOSED ASPHALT PAVEMENT IS TO MATCH EXISTING ASPHALT PAVEMENT, SAW CUT CRACKED OR DAMAGED EXISTING PAVEMENT IN NEAT, STRAIGHT LINES TO CREATE A CLEAN BUT JOINT AND REMOVE DAMAGED PAVEMENT. COAT EDGE OF EXISTING PAVEMENT WITH ASPHALT PRIOR TO PLACING PROPOSED ASPHALT
- 9. SAFETY REQUIREMENTS OUTLINED IN THE STATE OF OHIO CONSTRUCTION SAFETY CODE FOR THIS TYPE OF WORK WILL BE ENFORCED AND THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE CODE ISSUED AS A GENERAL ORDER BY THE INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION OF OHIO.
- 10. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL AT THE END OF EACH WORK DAY REMOVE AND/OR SWEEP ANY MUD OR DEBRIS FROM THE ROAD PAVEMENT SURFACE.
- 11. CONTRACTOR TO REMOVE TREES AND CLEAR AREAS AS NECESSARY TO PERFORM ALL SITE WORK INCLUDING GRADING AND
- 12. ALL FILL UNDER PAVEMENT SHALL BE COMPACTED TO THE GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEER'S RECOMMENDATIONS.
- 13. ADJUST ALL EXISTING CASTINGS WITHIN PROJECT AREA TO GRADE AS REQUIRED.
- 14. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE ALL APPROPRIATE MEASURES TO CONTROL SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION THROUGH THE LIFE OF THE CONTRACT AS REQUIRED BY SYCAMORE TOWNSHIP, HAMILTON COUNTY AND THE OHIO EPA. THIS MAY BE PERFORMED BY THE USE OF MULCHES, FILTER FABRICS AND OTHER DEVICES AND METHODS. PARTICULAR CARE SHALL BE TAKEN TO AVOID EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION ON EXISTING PAVED AND GRAVELED AREAS AND INTO THE SEWER SYSTEM.
- 15. ALL GROUND SURFACE AREAS THAT HAVE BEEN EXPOSED OR LEFT BARE AS A RESULT OF CONSTRUCTION AND ARE TO FINAL GRADE AND ARE TO REMAIN SO SHALL BE SEEDED AND MULCHED AS SOON AS PRACTICAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE OF OHIO SPECIFICATIONS ITEM 659 AND THE RAIN WATER AND LAND DEVELOPMENT MANUAL (ODNR, 2006).
- 16. ALL PROPOSED STORM SEWER, SURFACE OR OTHER DRAINAGE FACILITIES ARE TO BE PRIVATE AND MAINTAINED BY THE OWNER.
- 17. ALL STORM STRUCTURES ARE ODOT TYPE UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
- 18. DISTANCES SHOWN FOR STORM SEWER PIPES ARE MEASURED FROM CENTER OF STRUCTURE. CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBLE FOR ACTUAL FIELD CUT LENGTH. COORDINATES FOR STORM STRUCTURES ARE SHOWN TO THE CENTER OF THE STRUCTURE.
- 19. ALL CATCH BASINS WITH DEPTH GREATER THAN 4.5' SHALL BE PROVIDED WITH STEPS. STEPS SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF ITEM 604.
- 20. AN 18" VERTICAL CLEARANCE IS TO BE MAINTAINED ON ALL SANITARY, STORM, AND WATER CROSSINGS.
- 21. ALL DIMENSIONS AND COORDINATES ARE TO THE FACE OF CURB, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
- 22. ALL STANDARD PARKING SPACES ARE 9' BY 18'. HANDICAP PARKING SPACES ARE 8' BY 18'.
- 23. PARKING LOT STRIPING SHALL BE 4" WIDE WHITE HIGHWAY-TYPE STRIPING APPLIED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PLAN.
- 24. SIGNAGE PLAN TO BE SUBMITTED SEPARATELY BY OTHERS.
- 25. STORM SEWER PIPE LABELED "STM" SHALL BE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING: PVC SDR-35, PVC PROFILE PIPE PER ODOT ITEM 707.33, OR HIGH DENSITY POLYETHYLENE PER ODOT ITEM 707.33. ALL STORM IS TO BE INSTALLED PER ODOT ITEM 603, TYPE A.
- 26. CONTRACTOR TO LAYOUT BUILDING BASED ON ARCHITECTURAL/FOUNDATION PLANS. SITE PLAN IS FOR CONCEPTUAL PURPOSES
- 27. PROPOSED AUDITORIUM IS FOR EXISTING USERS WITHIN HOSPITAL ONLY.

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
