

WAYNESVILLE PUBLIC ART COMMISSION MINUTES-REGULAR MEETING JUNE 12TH, 2025 THURSDAY, 4:00PM TOWN HALL

Chairman George reminded the Commission that there's another Art After Dark 4th of July. Given that it's a holiday, George, Kathy, and Steve offered to sell shirts at the August 1st Art After Dark instead.

5. Other Business

Candace updated WPAC on Chefs On Fire. She said that Ben of Ben's Backdraft BBQ quoted \$2000 for the food, unless he can get some donated. She said the contract is signed with Frog Level, and event ticket sales and promotion will begin in July. She added that she is working on the TDA Capital Grant in the amount of \$15000 for the Main Street Mural.
