New Business:

- Abby Batten did a presentation to the board re: child care, mother's morning out, summer camp and the volleyball clinic for girls.
- The Town of Waynesville increased all fees by 5% effective July 1.
- The Waynesville Recreation Center now offers wireless.
- The Board of Aldermen gave the approval to move forward with fundraising efforts for a skate park.
- The Richland Creek Bank Stabilization project is now complete.
- A new crown was recently placed on the infield at the softball field at Recreation Park.
- We held the Trout City Celebration on July 1. This was done in conjunction with the Haywood County Chamber of Commerce. The event went well and we had around 100 people in attendance.
- Michael Huffstetler has completed one of two weeks for a new adventure camp program. The goal is to offer this throughout the summer in '09.
- Sarah Massie asked if we could go ahead and move the weight equipment and kiln at the Old Armory.
- We have 74 players registered for the Britannia Soccer Camp.
- We have 13 players registered for the basketball camp.
- Our second Vision Team meeting will take place on Tuesday, July 15, at 6 pm.
- This will be a tight fiscal year for FY 09. The Town has asked each department to be very conservative in spending this year. We had three CIP items approved (alarm system, fence for softball field at Recreation Park, and new games in the game room at the Waynesville Recreation Center).
