MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 5:35 pm.

New Business:

- Michelle Claytor was introduced as a new member to the Advisory Commission.
- A presentation was given to 15 students representing the Waynesville Skate Club at the Waynesville Middle School re: the progress of the Skate Park. A presentation was also given to skaters at Canton Middle School. This included over 60 students. A request was made to each group to participate in the fundraising efforts for the park.
- We now have 5 quotes for the VGB compliance for the pools. We will award the bid soon.
- There will be a Citizen Board Membership 101 teleconference on March 7 at UNCA. We will take the WPRD van if anyone would like to attend.
- We will offer an NFL Flag Football league for kids in June and July.
- We had a meeting with the Waynesville Middle School student council regarding programming for this age group. A Zumba class was suggested as well as field trips. We also discovered to use texting and Face Book as marketing devices for this age group.
- We also held a fundraising dance for the skate park and it went well.
- It has been suggested that we sponsor a motorcycle run in order to raise money for the ASPY program. If this takes place it will be held on May 9.
- There is a possibility that the Haywood County Government will not be able to give their annual \$70,000 for recreation to the Town of Waynesville. Therefore, we are researching alternative ideas if this occurs.
- Lee Starnes reported that the Mountaineer Little League will purchase new fencing for the t-ball field.
- We now have our second Vision Team formed. The first meeting was held in March.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:30 pm. Wallace Messer made the motion and Lee Starnes second it.
