New Business:

- The gym will be closed from September 8 to 14 in order for the floor to be refinished.

- Silver Sneakers now has an enrollment of 460 members. Our goal is 500 by December.
- The summer camp made a net profit of over \$12,000.

- We will have youth trips planned throughout the school year beginning with a trip to Chuck E. Cheese on Saturday, September 12.
- We will begin a new weight lifting program for middle school students.

- We did not receive the PARTF grant. Only 3 of 22 applicants from the Western Region was awarded a grant. We ranked 40 out of 85 statewide.

- We are planning a demo day for the skate park this fall.
- The Howell Mill Road project is still being negotiated.
