MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 5:47 pm.

New Business:

- The monthly report for January was reviewed.
- Updates were given on program divisions which included adult basketball, swim lessons, a new Zumba class at 4:30 pm on Monday, Wednesday and Fridays, and an snow tubing trip to Wolf Laurel.
- We have developed a practice schedule for the Emergency Operations Plan for the department. This will entail the entire department meeting four times a year on a Sunday evening at 7 pm and each division meeting four times a year between the departmental dates. Finally, all new hires will be given a copy of the EOP and their supervisor will review it with them.
- Our program guides are on schedule. Our next publication will be the youth program guide.
- The Town has hired Spohn Ranch to design the Waynesville Skate Park. The first design meeting will take place on March 2 at 7 pm at the WRC.
- We have established a marketing promotion with businesses and their customers. For example, we will offer the Haywood EMC and their customers a free weekend on May 28, 29 and 30 and a year membership with the 12 month being free. Currently, Haywood EMC has over 20,000 customers. We will also receive recognition on their website as well.
- We will begin an awards program on a quarterly basis beginning April 1. We will recognize a member of the WRC and a part-time employee. The winners will receive a 20 x 30 picture self-portrait to be displayed in the WRC lobby as well as the rights to a specific parking place. We will send out a press release and there will be recognition on our website. Finally, I will take the winners to lunch.
- We are getting new floors in the locker rooms (men and women) at the WRC.
- Some of major CIPs we are asking for includes a new roof for the gym, new roof for the racquetball courts, a new copier, new pool surface, new fitness equipment and an indoor climbing wall.
- The entire advisory commission agreed that it was a bad idea to move maintenance to the Old Armory thereby closing a portion of it to the public. Rhett would draft a letter and Kenny would sign it. This would be sent to the Board of Aldermen.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:30 pm.
