New Business:

- We reviewed the month of June. We had the second best fiscal year for revenue in the history of the Department.
- We recently held the Crossfire Basketball Camp for the first time. It went very well and we had over 90 campers. We also had a girls volleyball camp with close to 30 participants.
- We will soon begin a tennis camp and our soccer camp is approaching 100 campers. Last year we had 107.
- Swim lessons in aquatics are going very well. We have also had a lot of other groups visit us this summer such as other summer camps, YMCA and YWCA.
- We have purchased new weight equipment for the upstairs area as well as the weight room. We also will be purchasing new cardio equipment. This has been approved in our new fiscal year.
- We have had a lot of participation in our senior trips to places such as the Asheville Tourists baseball game, Dillard House, Grove Park Inn for breakfast and nature trips.
- Summer camp has been going well. We have close to 30 kids each week. They also take a field trip once per week.
- We are going to postpone the Region 9 Disc Golf Tournament until April 2011.
- The last public meeting for the Waynesville Skate Park will be on Monday, July 26 at the Waynesville Recreation Center. The design plan will then go before the Board of Aldermen on Tuesday, July 27, for final approval.
- We now have a new break room for the staff. It is in the concession stand.
- We have a new waiting area for customers waiting for a massage, personal training or any other appointments with staff members.
- We had our second departmental meeting on Sunday, June 27. Waynesville Police Chief Bill Hollingshed and Waynesville Fire Chief Joey Webb were the guest speakers. Our primary focus was how to prepare for someone shooting a gun within the facility.
