#### New Business:

- Mr. Phil Gibbs and Mr. Bob Clark did a presentation based on the needs of a restroom at Obama-King Park. The motion was made for the Advisory Commission to support their request. All voted yes and the motion carried. Mr. Gibbs and Mr. Clark will now speak to the Town of Waynesville Board of Aldermen at the March 23 meeting.
- We would like to ask the WPRD Advisory Commission their recommendation of having a public input meeting for the PARTF application regarding the Richland Creek Greenway, bridge and other recreational elements. The Advisory Commission requested that the meeting be held on Thursday, March 25, at 5:30 pm at the Waynesville Recreation Center. A press release for the meeting will be distributed to the local media. Also, a public survey was created by Equinox and the link placed on the Waynesville Parks and Recreation Department home page. A press release will also be sent asking people to visit the home page and fill out the survey. The purpose of the public meeting and survey is to gather as much information as possible for the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund grant application.
- The new restrooms in Recreation Park are now open to the public.
- The decision for summer camp will be made in mid to late April.
