Old Business:

The incident with Mike Dixon has been finalized and both parties are resigned as to the outcome. Area softball providers will be meeting over the winter months to establish safety rules for next year.

New Business:

Aerobics and Yoga classes are still being scheduled but instructors are getting increasingly harder to find.

The **after school child care** program is under way for grades K-5. Cost is \$15.00 per day.

Learn to swim classes have been held for Junaluska school 3rd grade and Hazelwood 3rd graders are in their first week of a two week session.

The Health Dept. is giving **flu shots** at the center all this week.

We are installing **security cameras** in the mezzanine, the lobby, and the weight room.

The center will be closed on **Thanksgiving Day**.
