## New Business:

- The spring softball league will only have 9 teams. Last spring there were 20 teams.
- We will be advertising for a new aquatics supervisor beginning in May.
- The Brain Gym is set up at the Old Armory and will soon be open for business. We will charge \$30 per person per year for the use of it. We will also have Wii games for seniors to play.
- The Game Room at the Waynesville Recreation Center is getting more popular. We will soon have programs established for children to compete in Wii tournaments.
- We no longer have the Old Armory Manager position. We will operate the facility by using programmers and receptionists at the front desk to take reservations, rentals and assist people.
- Pepsi has agreed to pledge \$7,500 over a 3 year period toward the Waynesville Skate Park.
- Beginning May 1 we will no longer offer the opportunity for individuals to pay by the class. Individuals must purchase a 6 visit punch card, 12 visit punch card, daily pass, monthly membership, quarterly membership, half a year membership or a yearly membership.
- We are partnering with the Waynesville Kiwanis in order to host a new event called "Spring Fling." This will take place on Saturday, May 21, from 10 am to 3 pm. We will have 3 inflatables for kids to play on, a dunking booth, free kids dog show, musical entertainment, tubing down the creek, slip and slide, games for kids, and a three point / free throw contest. Also, the entire Saturday will be "Haywood County Resident Day." All residents will get in free at the Center.
