ADVISORY COMMISSION MEETING

February 16, 2016 5:30 PM

MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 pm.

In attendance were: Kenny Mull, Wallace Messer, Michelle Claytor, Dan Shultz, Lee Starnes and Rhett Langston. Sarah Massie, Linda O'Niel, Heath Sutton and Don Frady were unable to attend.

• The minutes were read and passed from the January 19, 2015 meeting.

New Business:

- Rhett presented the January monthly report.
- New Timing System for pool—Jay MacDonald, president of SMAC, informed the advisory commission that the Haywood County TDA grant was approved in the amount of \$15,000. Also, private donations in the amount of \$2,100 in savings and \$2,900 from donors have been committed. SMAC will put \$5,000 towards the system. SMAC is asking the Town of Waynesville to also put forth \$5,000. The advisory commission voted and agreed to do that (Lee Starnes made the recommendation and Dan Shultz seconded it). Rhett will look into the funding coming out of this fiscal year and the pool capacity for people.
- Tim Petrea presented the drawing of new disc golf course at Hazelwood Park. It would be located in the woods that is currently owned by Ms. Nancy Wade of Atlanta. The primary reasons to move the current disc golf course to this location is to have a dedicated true course without other interruptions and the safety factor of not hitting other people with the discs. We will meet with Ms. Wade on Friday, February 19 to discuss the idea in further detail. The advisory commission approved the concept with a vote (Wallace made the recommendation and Lee Starnes seconded it).
- The new weights and weight machines have arrived.
- Rhett, David Foster, Darryl Hannah, and Preston Gregg met at the dog park about the drainage issue. It was recommended to install a French drain at the cost of \$2,000. The advisory commission discussed the issue and decided to evaluate the park over the next month after it rains before making a decision.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:57 pm.
