MINUTES

- New Business:
- The monthly report for May was reviewed.
- We have 85 children for summer camp this year. This will the largest summer camp we've ever had at the WRC.
- We have 30 girls in our volleyball camp. We will also offer two soccer camps and two basketball camps.
- Ginny Boyer will be going off the advisory commission. We really appreciate the time she has spent with us.
- We have contacted Court One about the current cracks on the tennis courts. They will send a representative to assess which cracks are under warranty and which cracks are new. Court One will be scheduled to repair the cracks in either August or September. The estimated cost will be close to \$5,000. We will continue this process each year until a new complex or new resurfacing is created.
- The Vance Street Park parking lot and the Old Armory parking lot will receive new paving.
- The Town of Waynesville will have a new developer on July 16. We hope to begin the master plan process at the end of the summer or early fall with assistance from the new developer.
- Blue Cross / Blue Shield will no longer offer Silver Sneakers. We will still continue the program because it is offered through Humana.
- Rhett gave a current status report on the CAPRA process. To date we have completed the following percentage of standards in the following subjects: Programs and Services Management—31%; Facilities and Land Use—24%; Public Safety and Law Enforcement—50%; Risk Management—67%; Evaluation Assessment and Research—23%; Planning—9%; Organization and Administration—85%; Human Resources—60%; Financial Management—45%; and Agency Authority—79%.
