The meeting was called to order at 5:30 pm.

New Business:

- Donald Hummel has started a new senior softball league. Currently, we have a team from Hendersonville and a team from Franklin that meets at Vance Street Park to play. We are hoping to get a team from Waynesville as well.
- Our aquatics division will offer "Whale Tail" and other American Red Cross water safety courses for our summer campers. We would also like to offer swim lessons if it is logistically possible.
- We will have two interns this summer from Western Carolina University. They will report to Tim Plowman and will assist him in physical training, senior trips and greenway work.
- As a member of Region 9, we have decided as a group that this year's fundraiser will be a disc golf tournament. This will take place on Saturday, August 21 and Sunday, August 22. Each day will begin at 10 am and should finish around noon. We will have a recreational and a professional division. The format will be captain's choice and we will have 5 five regional sites consisting of Waynesville (Central), Mars Hill College (North), Black Mountain (East) and Fletcher (South). The championship on Sunday will be played at Richmond Hill in Asheville. The top 4 rec teams and top 4 pro teams from each division will compete in Asheville on Sunday. We hoping to achieve \$25 hole sponsorships at each location as well as at least 10 rec teams from each regional site. The cost is \$35 per rec team and \$50 per pro team. Each team will consist of 2 people (any male/female combo).
- For the first time ever we are accepting registrations by the day for the summer camp this year.
- The Vision Team meeting was held on April 19. It went well and we had several good ideas from the meeting.
- Special Olympics was held Friday, May 7. The event went very well and the weather was perfect!
