- The monthly report from November was reviewed.
- The Military Racquetball Rehab Clinic would like to use our racquetball courts from 11:30 am to 2 pm on December 20 for a demonstration to veterans. They would also like to us to consider the possibility of an 8 week teaching clinic as well. The Advisory Commission discussed this idea and it was agreed to allow a free clinic on December 20 but charge the non—profit rate for the 8 week session.
- Relay for Life would like to request the use of our facility free of charge from 6 pm on May 9 to 7 am on May 10. It was discussed by the Advisory Commission and agreed to waive the fee.
- There have been many requests for lights at the skate parks. The town's position at this time is to request the skaters to raise the funds necessary for the lights.
- The possibility of a "no smoking" policy in our parks was discussed by the Advisory Commission. The final decision was not to have a policy for outdoors and just keep it for inside at the Waynesville Recreation Center and Old Armory Recreation Center.
- We are planning to have a new tri-fold brochure for all trails and greenways. This will be a partnership with Canton, Maggie Valley, Lake Junaluska, Haywood County and the Town of Waynesville.
