Taxi Driver Regulation

Each person who intends on being employed as a Taxi Driver or who intends on being a self employed Taxi Driver must meet the following guidelines and requirements. There will be no exceptions made in the requirements.

- Must have a current drivers license issued by the state of North Carolina.
- Driver must not have been convicted of more than one DWI within the past 3 years.
- Driver cannot be a convicted felon.
- Each driver will submit to being fingerprinted.
- Cannot have been convicted of a violation of any federal or state law relating to possession for sale or sale of any intoxicating alcoholic beverage or controlled substance.
- Cannot have been in violation of any federal law relating to prostitution
- Cannot have been a habitual violator of traffic laws or ordinances

The attached application must be filled out and sworn to under oath. Any false representations or omissions will result in the immediate revocation of their taxi Permit. The driver must have in their possession a valid Taxi Permit issued by the Waynesville Police Department prior to operating and Taxi Cab.
