Duties of the Maintenance and Repair department include:

- Repair and reconstruct streets and alleys
- ♦ Asphalt paving
- Plow and salt city right-of-way during inclement weather
- Mowing of city right-of-way and city properties
- Painting of traffic control lines and markings
- Removal of trees in the city rightof-way
- ♦ Install and maintain traffic signals
- ♦ Install and maintain traffic control and street signs
- ♦ Sweeping of the streets
- ♦ Leaf collection
- ♦ Maintenance of city owned vehicles and equipment
- Transport and set up the Mobile Sound Stage
